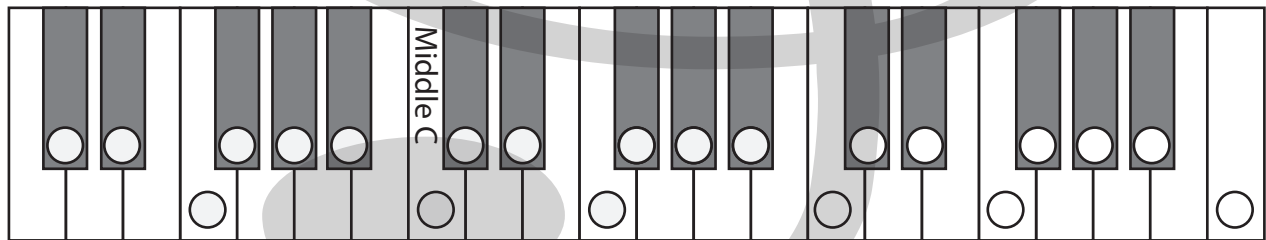
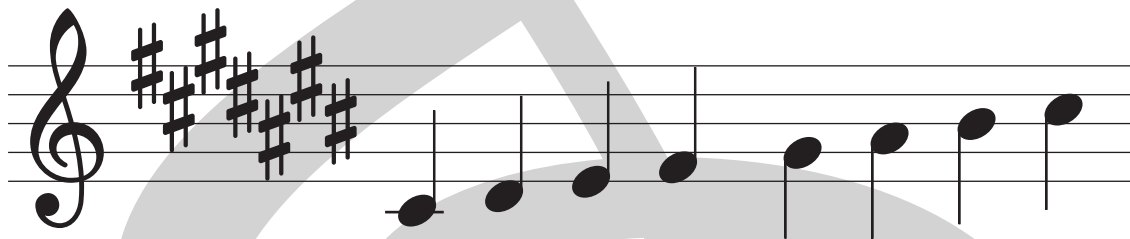

G Major, Low Octave, Ascending Guitar 1st Position, Scale, by String

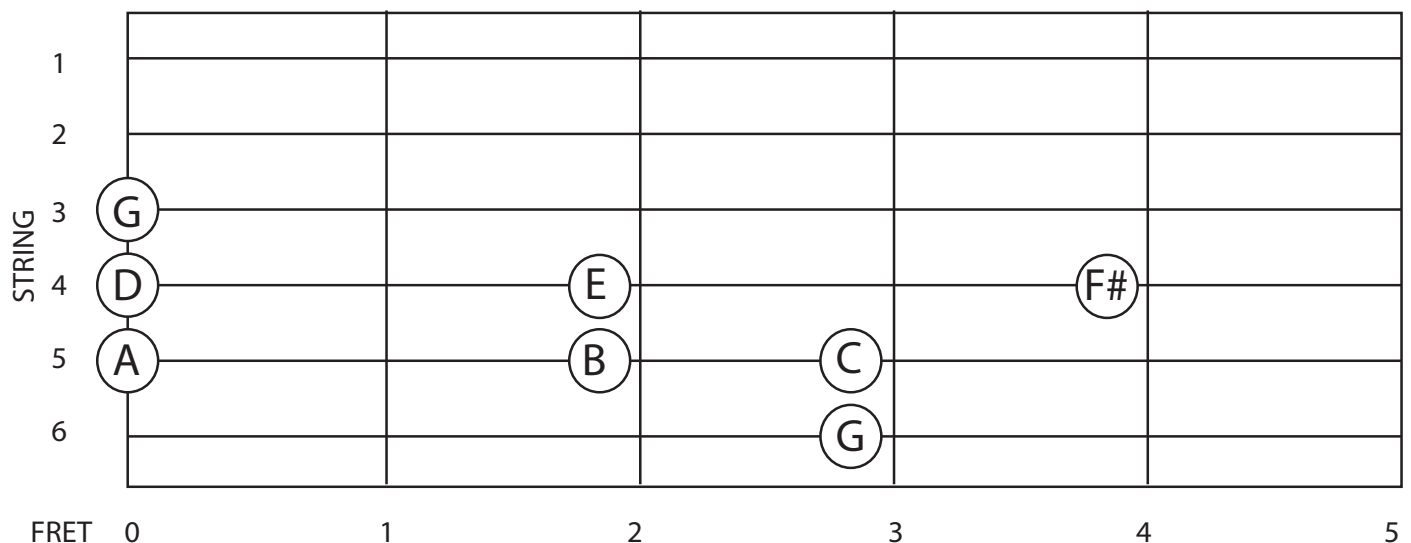
String E 6 | A 5 | D 4 | G 3

Notes by String.

- 6th string E, play notes G.
- 5th string A, play notes A, B, and C.
- 4th string D, play notes D, E, and F#
- 3rd string G, play notes G and A.
- 2nd string B, play notes B, C, and D.
- 1st string E, play notes E, F#, and G.

GUITAR

G Major, Low Octave, Guitar 1st Position Fretboard



Fingering Guidelines.

Guitar Left Hand Fingerings for 1st position.

Play notes on fret 0 open.

Play notes on fret 1 with index finger.

Play notes on fret 2 with middle finger.

Play notes on fret 3 with ring finger.

Play notes on fret 4 with ring finger.

Right Hand.

If using pick, alternate with up and down stroke.

If using fingers, play low strings (4,5,6) with the thumb,

Play treble strings (1,2,3) with any combination of index, middle, and ring.

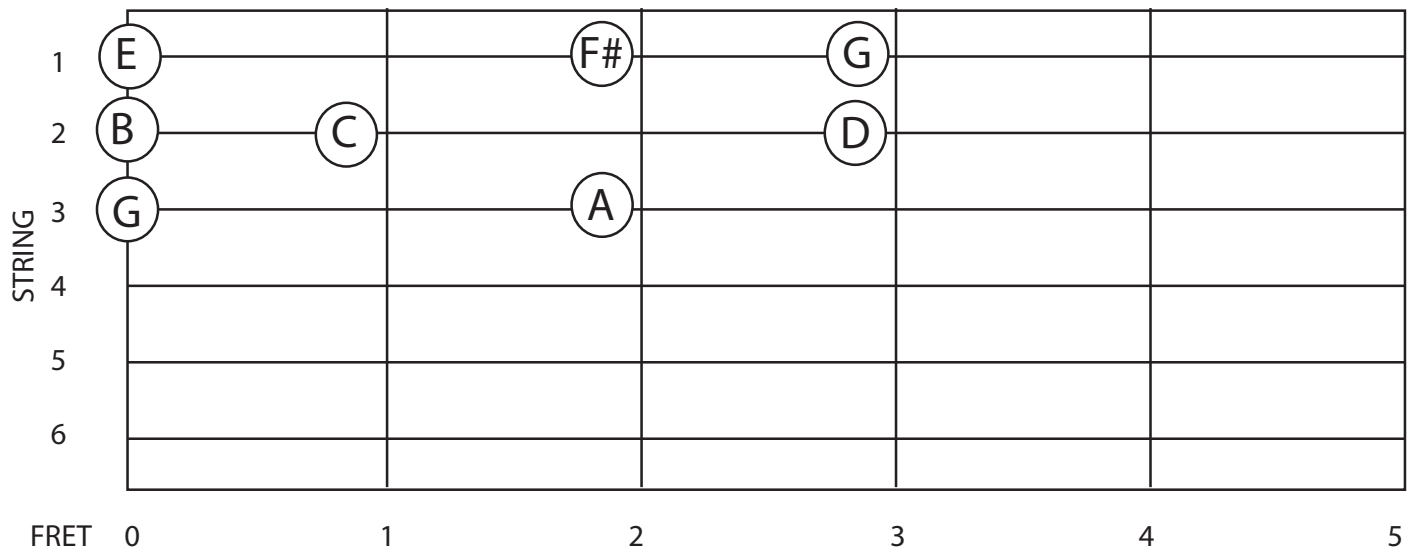

6th string E, play notes (E,F) G, (A).

5th string A, play notes A, B, C, (D).

4th string D, play notes D, E, F#, (G).

3rd string G, play notes G and A.

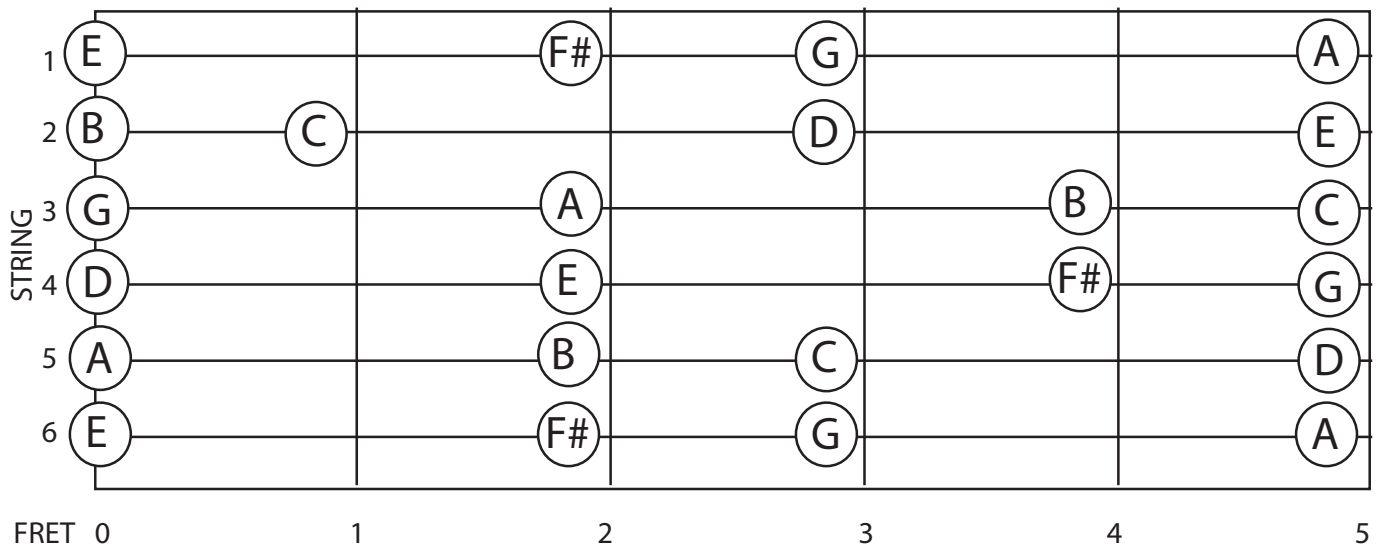
2nd string B, play notes B, C, and D.

1st string E, play notes E, F#, G, (A).

Fingering Guidelines.

Play notes on fret 0 open.

Play notes on fret 1 with index finger.

Play notes on fret 2 with middle finger. (or slide hand up 1 fret, and play with index.)

Play notes on fret 3 with ring finger. (or slide hand up 1 fret and play with middle.)

Play notes on fret 4 with pinky. (or slide hand up 1 fret and play with ring.)

Play notes on fret 5 with pinky.

Play D on the 2nd string, 3rd fret, with the ring.

Play C on the 2nd string, 1st fret, with index. (Or 3rd string, 5th w/ pinky.)

Play B on the 2nd string, open. (Or on the 3rd string, 4th fret, w/pinky.)

Play A on the 3rd string, 2nd fret, with middle finger.

Play G on the 3rd string, open. (Or on the 4th string, 5th fret, w/ pinky.)

Play F# on the 4th string, 4th fret, with the pinky.

Play E on the 4th string, 2nd fret, with middle finger.

Play D on the 4th string, open. (Or on the 5th string, 5th fret, w/ pinky.)

Play C on the 5th string, 3rd fret, with the ring finger.

Play B on the 5th string, 2nd fret, with the middle finger.

Play A on the 5th string, open (or the 6th string, 5th fret, with pinky.)

Play low G on the 6th string, 3rd fret, with the ring finger.
