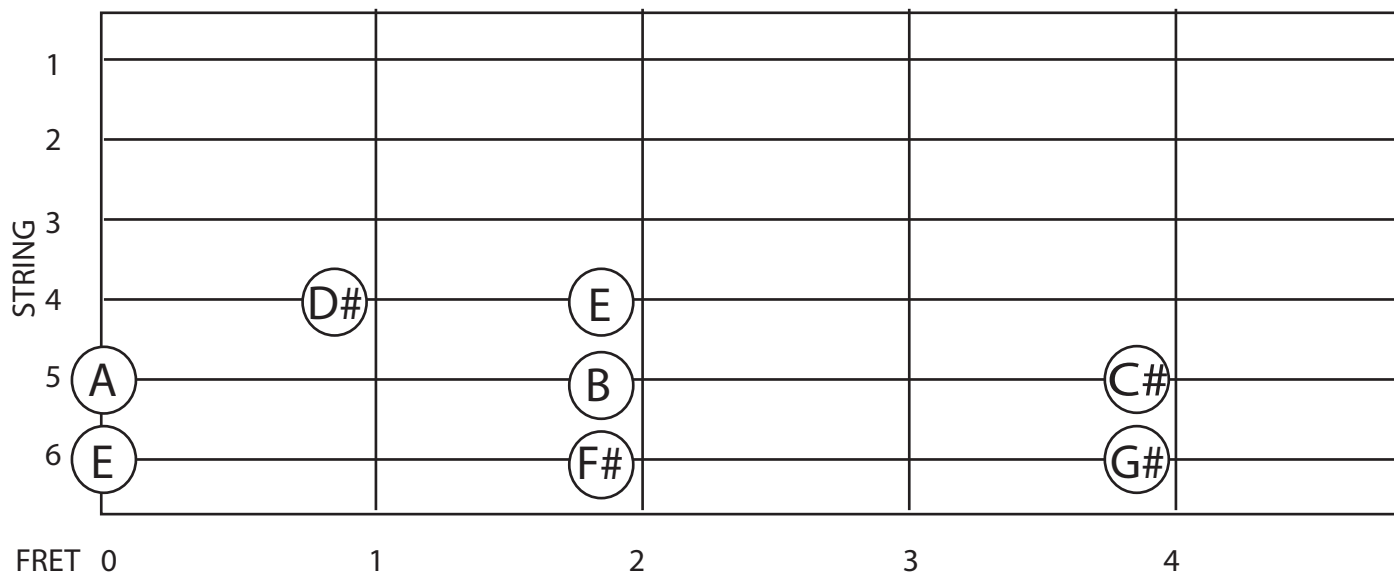


E Major, Low Octave, Relative to Keyboard

Fingering Guidelines.

Play notes on fret 0 open.

Play notes on fret 1 with index finger.

Play notes on fret 2 with middle finger.

Play notes on fret 3 with ring finger.

Play notes on fret 4 with pinky.

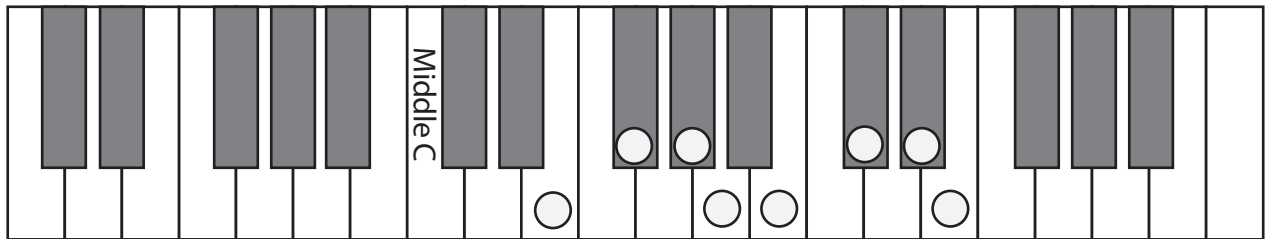
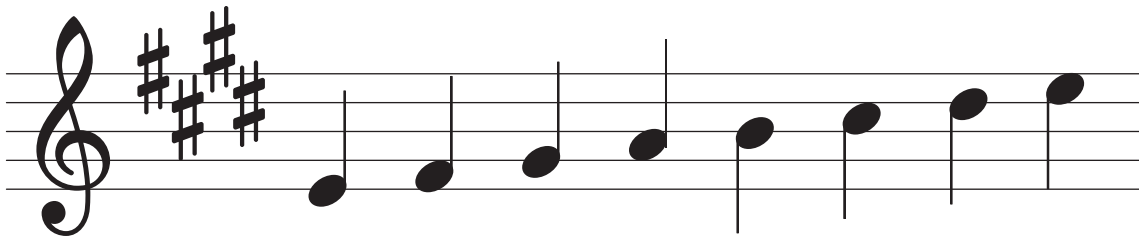

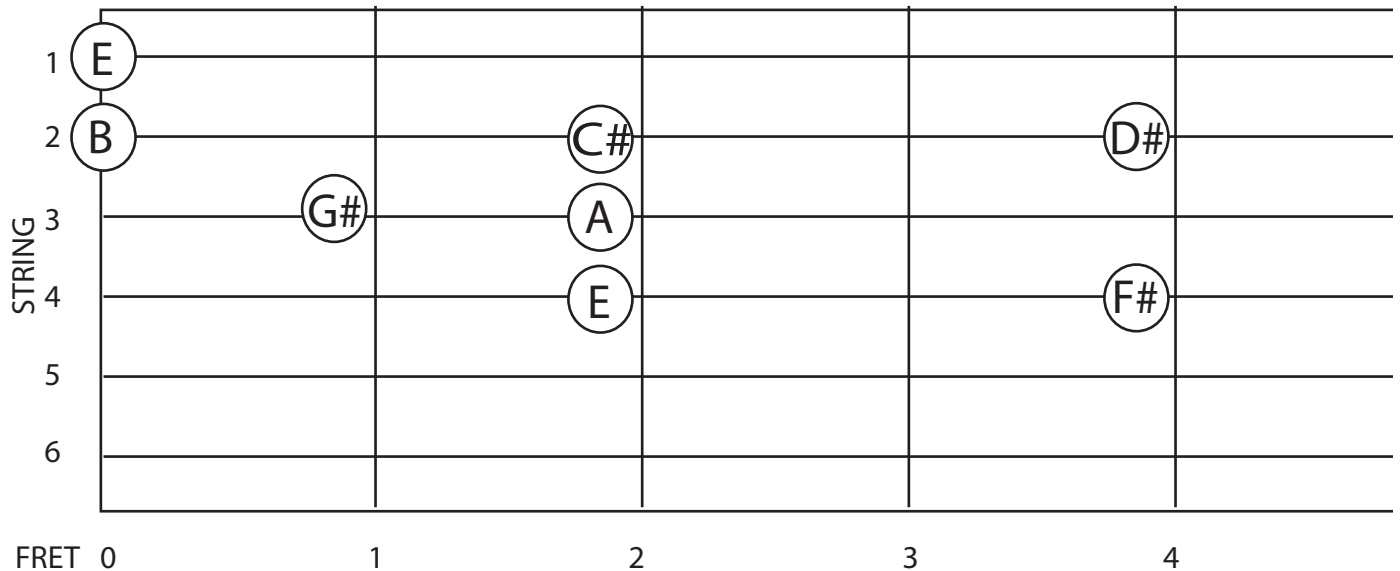

Play notes on fret 3 with ring finger.

Play notes on fret 4 with ring or pinky.

Play notes on fret 5 with pinky.
